The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated September 9, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on June 4, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the following Sundays: September 18 and 25, 2022 is hereby approved.

The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete planned work that has been delayed due to inclement weather and a delay in securing an outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated September 9, 2022.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on two additional Sundays: September 18 and 25, 2022 for the above-referenced project. The additional extended hours are needed in order to complete planned work that was delayed due to the inability to work during the excessive rainfall event that occurred on September 5th and 6th. The planned work was further impeded by a delay in securing the outage needed to commence the work. The work hours requested are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Please note that at the time of the September 2, 2022 request to the Siting Council for Sunday work hours, which was approved, the project team did not anticipate the extent of the rainfall or the delay in the outage and the resulting loss of work time. We have notified the Town of Lebanon of our intention to submit this request to the Council. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
