The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated November 10, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on June 4, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 13, 2022 and Monday, November 14, 2022 is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary to complete work within the substation yard and control house during a scheduled outage that has been shortened in duration.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated November 10, 2022.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 13, and Monday, November 14, 2022, for the above-referenced project. The extended hours are needed to regain the project construction schedule in order to complete the work within the scheduled outage, the duration of which has been shortened from the original schedule. The outage cannot be adjusted without interrupting other Eversource projects and cannot be rescheduled until January. During the extended hours, workers will be performing testing within the control house. We have notified the Town of Ledyard of our intention to submit this request to the Council. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
