The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated December 13, 2021, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on July 30, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 am until 8:00 p.m. from December 15 through December 17, December 20 through December 23, December 27 and December 28, and from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 19, 2021, is hereby approved.

The additional work hours are necessary to perform work within already-scheduled lines outages. Work has been delayed due to equipment delivery issues.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated December 13, 2021. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

In accordance with the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council's) July 30, 2021 approval of the above-referenced petition, The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy (Eversource) is in the process of modifying the existing Killingly Substation, including the addition of a new 25.2 MVAR capacitor bank, reactors, and other equipment. Whereas most construction work has been proceeding as scheduled, global supply chain issues is causing an approximately one month delay in the transportation to the substation of the capacitor bank and reactors. As a result, while scheduled to be delivered by 11/19/21 this equipment will not be delivered until the week of 12/13/21.

To maintain the project schedule pursuant to already-scheduled outages, Eversource requests, pursuant to Condition 1 of the Council's petition approval, extended work hours of 7AM to 7PM on Sunday, December 19<sup>th</sup> and 7AM to 8PM on the weekdays of December 15<sup>th</sup> through December 23<sup>rd</sup> and December 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. Normal work hours at the substation work site, as approved by the Council, are 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Saturday.

During the proposed extended work shifts, Eversource's contractors will perform work to install the capacitor bank and other equipment, all within the substation and on Eversource property. Killingly Substation is in an industrial /commercial area of the Town of Killingly.

Eversource has consulted with representative of the Town of Killingly regarding this extended work hour request.
