The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated August 2, 2023, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on July 30, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 6, 2023 is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary to accommodate a scheduled outage due to summer electric loads.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary changes to work hours dated August 2, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource is requesting approval from Council staff for Sunday work hours (7 AM to 7 PM) on August 6 for work activities within a new scheduled outage to accommodate a CONVEX outage requirement due to summer loads. The work would primarily be in the new control enclosure with minimal work in the substation yard, such as removing wires and connections. No large construction equipment would be used. The project team will aim to minimize occurrence of these noise generating activities to the extent possible during the requested Sunday.

Eversource has provided notice to the Town of Mansfield and abutters regarding the proposed work hours.
