Dear Helen Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated November 17, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on July 30, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition Nos. 1 and 3 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the following Sundays: November 27, December 4, December 11, 2022; **and 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on December 18, 2022 (first night of Hanukkah)** is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete work during a scheduled outage and maintain the project schedule.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated November 17, 2022.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource is requesting approval from Council staff for Sunday work hours (7 AM to 7 PM) on November 27, December 4, December 11, and December 18 to complete work within the scheduled outage. The work activity would primarily be within the control house and testing equipment. In addition, the transformer assembly will take place inside the substation yard (north side). The work will generate minimal noise (i.e. no back up alarms, construction equipment, etc.). These Sunday work hours are needed to recover lost of time due to delays in equipment and material delivery.

Eversource has provided notice to the Town of Mansfield and abutters regarding these proposed work hours.
