RE: **PETITION NO. 1456** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Card to Willimantic Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 0.77 mile of its existing No. 1210 115-kilovolt (kV) line and approximately 0.81 mile of its existing No. 1220 115-kV line within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Card Substation in Lebanon and Willimantic Substation in Windham, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of a petition for a declaratory ruling to make modifications to existing electric transmission lines in the Towns of Lebanon and Windham.
