On July 27, 2022, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued interrogatories to Homestead Fuel Cell 1, LLC ("HFC1" or the "Company") concerning the Development and Management Plan ("D&M Plan"). In order to respond to the Council's interrogatories, HFC1 requested and received an extension until November 1, 2022. The request was based, in part, on HFC1's need to select and retain an engineering, procurement and construction ("EPC") contractor.

Unfortunately, the Company and its EPC contractor have not been able to respond to the Council's interrogatories and therefore the Company requests an additional extension for the filing of interrogatory responses until March 1, 2023. HFC1 will endeavor to respond to the Council's interrogatories in advance of the requested extension deadline date. Additionally, as we discussed, the Company consents to an extension of the Council's deadline for decision until May 1, 2023.
