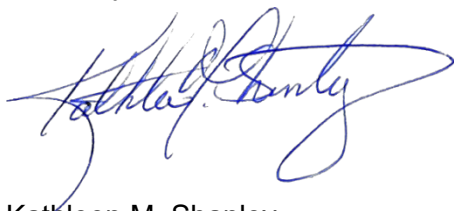
Dear Ms. Bachman,

On October 7, 2021 the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) considered and ruled that the above-referenced project would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16- 50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. Condition #2 of the Council’s ruling required that Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) submit a copy of the final visual impact mitigation plan to the Council.
