Re: **PETITION NO. 1459** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed modifications to its existing Shunock Substation located at 25 Pendleton Hill Road, North Stonington, Connecticut and related electric transmission line structure improvements.

## Dear Attorney Bachman:

At a public meeting held on October 7, 2021, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") considered and ruled that the above-referenced proposal would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. Among other conditions of the acknowledgement, the Council required that Eversource submit the following item:

• Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed along with a representative photograph of the facility modification. (Condition 5)

Construction was completed on July 25, 2024.

Additionally, representative photographs of the completed modification(s) to the existing substation facility, is included as *Attachment A*.

Eversource will be providing one original and two hard copies of this notice in the mail for the Council's records.
