The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated August 1, 2023 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on October 8, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM on the following Sundays – August 6, August 13, and September 3, 2023 - is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to perform work within the substation during scheduled outages.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated August 1, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., on 8/6/2023, 8/13/2023 and 9/3/2023 for Petition 1459 (North Stonington) at Shunock Substation. Sunday work is required for a scheduled outage needed to energize the breaker in the motor control center unit for the synchronous condenser and to energize the low and high side of the new transformer supplying power to the synchronous condenser.

We have notified the Town of North Stonington of our intention to submit this request to the Council and they did not have any objections. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
