**RE: Proposed installation of solar electric generating facility to be located at 129
Bartholomew Road, Goshen, Connecticut**

To Whom It May Concern:

I write on behalf of Greenskies Clean Energy LLC ("Greenskies"), which intends to file with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") a petition for declaratory ruling ("Petition") that a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is not required.

The Petition addresses the construction, operation and maintenance of a 4.0 megawatt ("MW") alternating current ground mounted solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 129 Bartholomew Road, Goshen, Connecticut ("Project"). The Project would be located on one parcel within Goshen's RA5 residential zoning district along the border of the Goshen-Cornwall town line. The Project area is privately owned, vacant farmland and totals approximately 13.5 acres on a 69.1 acre parcel. The Project would include the installation of photovoltaic modules, inverters and transformers, electrical lines and a perimeter fence.

Greenskies develops, finances, constructs, and maintains clean energy projects. Greenskies selected the Project site because it is suitable for a solar project and would have minimal impact on the environment and community. The Project also qualified for the State of Connecticut's Shared Clean Energy Facilities ("SCEF") program. Through the SCEF program, the revenue generated from the landowners' lease with Greenskies would allow the landowners to revive agricultural activities on the property and to support the State's commitment to renewable energy.

This letter serves as notice to you as an abutting property owner pursuant to § 16-50j-40 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. Greenskies will file the Petition on or about August 13, 2021 and will request that the Council place the Petition on some future agenda.
