RE: **PETITION NO. 1422** - CF Mulnite LLC Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the construction, maintenance and operation of a 4.99-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at Mulnite Farms, Inc. off Barber Hill Road west of the intersection with Rockville Road, East Windsor, Connecticut and associated electrical interconnection.

**PETITION NO. 1463** – CF Mulnite Miller, LLC Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the construction, maintenance and operation of a 1.0-megawatt (MW) AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at a Mulnite Farms, Inc. parcel off Wapping Road, and a 4.0 MW AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at a Mulnite Farms, Inc. parcel off Miller Road, East Windsor, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection.

On February 5, 2024, pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), CF Mulnite LLC filed a Motion to Reopen and Modify (Motion to Reopen) the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) above-referenced April 26, 2021 Declaratory Ruling issued in Petition 1422 and January 14, 2022 Declaratory Ruling issued in Petition 1463 for the construction, maintenance and operation of solar photovoltaic electric generating facilities in the Town of East Windsor, Connecticut, based on changed conditions.

The Motion to Reopen the Council's April 26, 2021 and January 14, 2022 Declaratory Rulings will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for February 29, 2024 for Council consideration.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), parties and intervenors to the original proceedings shall be notified of the Motion to Reopen and given an opportunity to participate. There were no parties and intervenors of record to the original proceedings when the final decisions on the petitions for declaratory rulings were rendered and therefore, there are no parties or intervenors of record to be notified of this Motion to Reopen nor to comment on this Motion to Reopen.
