RE: **PETITION NO. 1464** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Rockville Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 1.2 miles of its existing No. 1606 and No. 1724 115-kilovolt transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Rockville Junction and Rockville Substation in Vernon, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated January 13, 2022 regarding project changes for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on November 18, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling on November 18, 2021, the request to shift the location of Structure 6713 from inside the Rockville Substation to a location 20 feet to the west, adjacent to West Main Street and on Eversource property, to avoid a recently discovered sewer main is hereby approved. Temporary construction matting will be used to protect an adjacent streambank during construction.

This approval applies only to the project changes in the correspondence dated January 13, 2022. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.
