Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the above-referenced project on the following Sundays: 4/24, 5/1, 5/8, 5/15, 5/22 and 5/29 to complete the project work during a scheduled outage. Due to the risk of a Single Contingency Loss (SCLL) situation the work has been confined to an 8 hour recall time, which is limiting the Project to pulling one conductor at a time (as opposed to all conductors at once). The Sunday work will be helpful with this one-conductor approach since it takes longer to pull one conductor vs 3 at once.

We have notified the Town of Vernon of our intention to submit this request to the Council. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
