**PETITION NO. 1468** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Montville to Horton Cove Rebuild Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 0.6 mile of its existing Nos. 100 69-kilovolt (kV) and No. 1410 115-kV electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Horton Cove and Montville Substation in Montville, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

## Dear Sue Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated March 15, 2023, regarding a temporary change to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on January 28, 2022.
