RE: **PETITION NO. 1468** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Montville to Horton Cove Rebuild Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 0.6 mile of its existing Nos. 100 69-kilovolt (kV) and No. 1410 115-kV electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Horton Cove and Montville Substation in Montville, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated June 2, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on January 28, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 5, 2022 from Structure Nos. 7003 through 7007C is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete line clipping of the optical ground wire and conductor installation during a rescheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated June 2, 2022. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Subject: Petition 1468: Montville to Horton Cove Project - Extended Hours, Sunday, June 5th

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource seeks Council staff approval for extended work hours for the above referenced Project on this coming Sunday, June 5th, from 8AM to 7PM. These additional work hours are needed due to a 1.5 day delay to the Project schedule as a result of not being able to work during an outage at Montville Substation planned for Tuesday, May 31st that could not take place due to the unavailability of backup generation. Further delay occurred on June 1st due to a feeder lockout alarm at the station that activated and needed to be addressed, resulting in switching delays.

This additional time on Sunday is necessary to complete line clipping of the OPGW and conductor installation during the planned outage which ends on June 5th. This work will take place at Structures 7003, 7003A, 7004, 7005, 7006, 7007A, 7007B and 7007C. The work will involve bucket and pick-up trucks for work crew access at each structure.

Eversource has notified the Town of Montville and it has no objection to these extended hours. The property owners abutting these locations will be notified of these extended hours.
