RE: **PETITION NO. 1468** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Montville to Horton Cove Rebuild Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 0.6 mile of its existing Nos. 100 69-kilovolt (kV) and No. 1410 115-kV electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Horton Cove and Montville Substation in Montville, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Sue Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated September 22, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on January 28, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 25, 2022 is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to continue the relay cut over process during an outage that was delayed due to inclement weather.

Work will be performed within the control enclosure.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated September 22, 2022.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
