

About

An Environmental Land Use Restriction (ELUR) is an easement granted to the Commissioner of DEEP by the property owner that is recorded on the municipal land records. The purpose of an ELUR is to minimize the risk of human exposure to pollutants and hazards to the environment by preventing specific uses or activities at a property. An ELUR is a tool to set remedial goals for a property to be used in the exposure risk associated with its use.
