Interrogatories

1. What is the total cost of the proposed project?
2. Provide construction work days/hours and the anticipated duration of construction.
3. Petition Section IV, No. 1 states “The compound expansion will alter an existing landscaped area adjacent to the Lowes parking lot. No native trees will be removed.” No. 2 states “The proposed compound expansion will be screened by the existing landscaping and will also have a minimal visual impact.” Describe the nature and extent of altering the existing landscaped area.
4. Why is the proposed location for the backup generator outside of the existing compound? Could the generator be installed within the existing compound?
5. What is the estimated run time for the proposed 15-kilowatt backup generator based on full load conditions and the fuel tank capacity?
