RE: **PETITION NO. 1475** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Eastern Connecticut Reliability Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 2.1 miles of its existing Nos. 100 and 400 69-kilovolt (kV) and Nos. 1410 and 1280 115-kV electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Montville Junction, Montville and Ledyard Junction, Ledyard, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.
