RE: **PETITION NO. 1483** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Dooley Substation to Scoville Rock Substation and Middletown Substation Structure Replacement Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 9 miles of its existing Nos. 387, 362, and 3041 115-kV electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way in Middletown, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Deborah Denfeld:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated March 15, 2023, regarding a temporary change to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on May 13, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 19, 2023 near Structure No. 23009 is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete work activities during a scheduled CONVEX outage due to a delay because of inclement weather earlier this week.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to work hours dated March 15, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource is requesting approval from Council staff for Sunday work hours (7 AM to 7 PM) on March 19 for work activities within a current scheduled outage in order to complete drilling operations for the foundation of new Structure #23009, prior to the end of the outage. The request is based on a loss of productivity due to inclement weather earlier this week. The structure is located north of Route 9 and south of Route 154, in Middletown. There may be some noise generating activities due to the natures of the drilled shaft, concrete foundation work. The project team will aim to minimize occurrence of these noise generating activities to the extent possible during the requested Sunday.

Eversource has provided notice to the Town of Middletown and abutters regarding these proposed work hours.
