Re: IW-JR-22-0036: 300 Seaside Av, Map 44, Block 432, Parcel 23; Bridgeport Hospital, Proposed fuel cell with no construction within 100' of a wetland or watercourse in the South-Central Shoreline Watershed.

Dear Ms. Young Gaudet:

The Milford Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency has reviewed the site plan entitled "Yale New Haven Health 300 Seaside Ave, Milford, CT" by Bloom Energy 2 sheets dated 9/01/21. A review of this information and the MIWA maps reveals no work is proposed within wetlands Watercourses or the 100' upland review area on the property. This proposed work, done with appropriate erosion and sedimentation controls should not have a significant impact on wetlands or watercourses. Therefore, under section 2 of the MIWA Regulations a permit is not required from the MIWA at this time. For protection of natural resources on and off the property please ensure that:

- Proper Soil erosion and sedimentation controls as outlined in the *CT DEEP 2002 Sedimentation and Erosion Control Manual* should be in place and functioning (i.e. silt sacks, silt fence, hay bales, coir fiber logs) until the site is stabilized.
- **No material** may be placed in or adjacent to catch basins leading to wetlands or watercourses
- Catch basins are protected during construction to prevent siltation from entering the stormwater system.
- All dumpsters are properly covered at night,
- All windblown debris is picked up,
- All materials are disposed of properly in an approved facility.

This letter applies only to the specific plans noted above. You are responsible for contacting other permitting authorities to determine if additional Local, State and Federal permits are required for this project.
