Cancellation of Approval

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On June 15, 2022, EIP Communications I, LLC (“EIP”) filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling for the replacement and extension of its existing telecommunications tower at 75 Wells Road in Wethersfield, Connecticut. These facility modifications were needed to accommodate proposed facility modifications by existing tenants (wireless carriers) at the site.

EIP was recently notified that, due to changes in project development budget priorities, certain wireless carriers are no longer planning to make their proposed facility modifications. The installation of a replacement tower and other site modifications is therefore no longer necessary and EIP respectfully requests that the Council cancel its Petition No. 1521 approval.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, EIP was recently notified that T-Mobile intends to proceed with certain facility modifications at the Wethersfield site. These modifications however can be accommodated without the need to replace the existing Wethersfield tower.
