RE: **PETITION NO. 1527** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Stevenson to Pootatuck Rebuild Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 8 miles of its existing Nos. 1560, 1808 and 1580 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Eversource's Stevenson Substation, 1 Roosevelt Drive in Monroe and The United Illuminating Company's Pootatuck Substation, 14 Old Stratford Road in Shelton, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Helen Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of email correspondence dated May 19, 2023, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on December 9, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 2 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 21, 2023, is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to install three structures in Shelton, and once installed, transfer the existing conductors to the new structures during a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary changes to work hours dated May 19, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource is requesting approval from Connecticut Siting Council staff for Sunday work hours (8 AM to 5 PM) on May 21 for erecting at structures 19616,19621 and 19622 and transferring the existing conductors to the new structures, located in Shelton. The schedule was delayed due to the mislabeling of the structure components from the manufacturer which delayed productivity by one day. The additional day is required to complete this work within the outage ending early Monday morning on May 22.
