RE: **PETITION NO. 1531** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed 1200/1300 Line Structure Replacement Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of approximately 0.39 mile of its existing No. 1200 and No. 1300 115-kilovolt electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Eversource's Windsor Locks Substation in Windsor Locks and Warehouse Point Junction in East Windsor, Connecticut and related transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Deborah Denfeld:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated April 4, 2023, regarding a temporary change to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on September 30, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. on April 4, 2023 is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary due to the evaluation and resolution of an incident that occurred earlier in the workday.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to work hours dated April 4, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
