RE: **PETITION NO. 1531** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed 1200/1300 Line Structure Replacement Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of approximately 0.39 mile of its existing No. 1200 and No. 1300 115-kilovolt electric transmission lines within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between Eversource's Windsor Locks Substation in Windsor Locks and Warehouse Point Junction in East Windsor, Connecticut and related transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Sue Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated November 7, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on September 30, 2022.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on the following Sundays: November 13, and December 4, 2022; with potential backup dates of November 20, and December 11, 2022 if necessary due to inclement weather is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to pull wires over Interstate 91 during off-peak hours per Connecticut Department of Transporation permit requirements.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated November 7, 2022.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
