Interrogatories

1. What is the estimated cost of each of the proposed projects?
2. Explain why the generator location was selected outside of the fenced compound rather than expanding the fenced compound to accommodate the generator and its associated clearance areas.
3. Section III, p. 2 of the Petitions refer to a 240-gallon fuel tank for the 48-kW generator model proposed at the site. The generator specification sheet for the 48-kW generator model refers to a 62-gallon fuel tank. Clarify.
4. What is the run time under full load conditions? How often would refueling be required?
5. What containment measures would be employed to protect against fluid leakage?
6. Referring to section IV, p. 2 of the Petitions, "Noise Effects," when would the weekly 12-minute run cycles occur (ex. during daytime hours)?
7. Referring to section V, p. 2 of the Petitions, has the Town and/or abutters provided comments to T-Mobile since the Petition filing? If yes, summarize the comments.
8. Section VI, p. 3 of the Petitions refer to the installation of a temporary tower at the property. Clarify.
9. Provide typical construction workdays and hours, the duration of construction and the projected start date for each project.
