On June 12, 2023, ReNew Developers, LLC ("ReNew" or the "Company") filed with the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") a Motion to Reopen and Modify the Council's Decision in Petition No. 1533 (the "Motion"). The Motion included an addendum titled *Petition Addendum - 18 MW Facility* (the "Addendum"). On page 21 of the Addendum, it is incorrectly stated that the nearest residential receptors are located 350 feet west of the Second Facility. The correct distance is 300 feet west of the Second Facility. Through this letter, the Company wishes to notify the Council of this correction and apologize for the oversight.
