Notice

8. Could the proposed soil stockpile area be relocated further from the Pequabuck River?
9. Would landscaping be installed? If so, provide details and drawings showing the landscaping locations and design.
10. Provide complete contact information (including phone numbers) for the spill response contractor, and local, state and federal agencies referenced in the Petroleum Materials Storage and Spill Prevention section of the Resource Protection Plan behind Tab E of the Petition.
