RE: **PETITION NO. 1545** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Wawecus Junction to Montville Junction Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement of electric transmission line structures along its existing 8-mile electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kilovolt (kV) Nos. 1000, 1070, 1080 and 1090 Lines between Wawecus Junction in Norwich and Montville Junction in Montville, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Deborah Denfeld:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated June 19, 2023 regarding project changes for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on January 20, 2023, as follows:

- a) Shift replacement Structure 6341 from approximately 10 feet north of the existing structure to approximately 10 feet south of the existing structure, to improve working clearances;
- b) Modify a portion of the off-ROW access road surface, between Gallivan Lane and Structure 6333, to add matting in lieu of gravel to mitigate the potential for ruts in the agricultural field; and
- c) Shift a portion of the matted access road towards the southern side of the Structure 7645 to avoid traversing a berm.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's January 20, 2023 Declaratory Ruling, the specified requests for project changes are hereby approved. This approval applies only to the project changes in the correspondence dated June 19, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

On January 20, 2023 the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") considered and ruled that the above referenced Petition would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. Condition 1 of the decision indicates any project changes be delegated to Council staff.

The following minor changes are proposed:

- Shift Replacment Structure 6341 to 10 feet back from existing structure, instead of 10 feet ahead, to accommodate improved working clearances (revised Map Sheets 7 & 8)
- Modify a portion of the off-ROW access road surface, between Gallivan Lane and Structure 6333, to add matting in lieu of gravel to mitigate the potential for rutting the agricultural field, as determined in consultation with the Property Owner (revised Map Sheet 9)
- Shift the matted access road to the south side of Structure 7645 to avoid traversing a berm, and instead enter the gravel work pad at an existing break location in the berm (revised Map Sheet 9)


