Re: **Petition 1549** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling for 1714 Line Rebuild Project.
Compliance with Condition 9 – Notice of Construction Completion

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On February 16, 2023, Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) was issued a ruling from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) stating that the proposed 1714 Line Rebuild Project (“Project”) would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect. Among other conditions of the ruling, the Council required that Eversource submits the following item pursuant to Condition 9:

- Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that the construction has been completed, along with a representative photograph of the project.

Project construction, including landscape restoration, was completed on May 15, 2026. A representative photograph of the completed Project, is included as *Attachment A*.

The electronic submittal of this notice is accompanied by a hard copy sent for the Council’s records.
