Dear Ms. Bachman:

This facility was approved by the Connecticut Siting Council, Petition No. 1559 on April 13, 2023, with 15 tower siting conditions. Please see attached. Attorney Kenneth Baldwin requested an Extension of Construction Time from the Connecticut Siting Council and received said extension on March 10, 2026. The purpose of this extension was to allow additional time to assemble and provide the CSC with the comments and/or the required conditional deliverables stated in this Petition, as follows:

1. Approval of any project changes be delegated to Council staff;

Comment: Acknowledged

2. Radio frequency access restriction and caution signage shall be installed at the site in compliance with FCC guidance;

Comment: Completed

3. Deployment of any 5G services must comply with FCC and FAA guidance relative to air navigation, as applicable;

Comment: Complied

4. Submission of the final construction drawings stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer duly licensed in the State of Connecticut prior to commencement of construction;

Comment: The Final Construction Drawings have been attached/provided as a PDF.

5. Submission of a structural analysis for the replacement tower/antenna mounts and foundation stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer duly licensed in the State of Connecticut prior to commencement of construction;

*Comment: The signed & stamped Structural Analysis Report has been attached/provided as a PDF.
Further, Crown has provided the passing tower inspection report.*

6. The final structural design shall include a yield point to ensure that the tower setback radius remains within the boundaries of the host property;

Comment: Please see the final page of the report prepared by Michael Plahovinsak, PE for full radius information.

7. Submission of a landscaping plan for the tower compound prior to commencement of construction;

8. The Council shall be notified in writing at least two weeks prior to the commencement of site construction activities;

Comment: Acknowledged

9. Unless otherwise approved by the Council, if the facility authorized herein is not fully constructed within three years from the date of the mailing of the Council's decision, this decision shall be void, and the facility owner/operator shall dismantle the facility and remove all associated equipment or reapply for any continued or new use to the Council before any such use is made. The time between the filing and resolution of any appeals of the Council's decision shall not be counted in calculating this deadline. Authority to monitor and modify this schedule, as necessary, is delegated to the Executive Director. The facility owner/operator shall provide written notice to the Executive Director of any schedule changes as soon as is practicable.

Comment: Tower has been constructed

10. Any request for extension of the time period to fully construct the facility shall be filed with the Council not later than 60 days prior to the expiration date of this decision and shall be served on all parties and intervenors, if applicable, and the City of Danbury;

Comment: Acknowledged

11. Unless otherwise approved by the Council, the existing wood laminate tower shall be removed within 180 days of the installation of the new steel monopole tower;

Comment: Wood tower will be removed after all carriers are installed on the new tower. Per Zoning conditions of approval, tower must be removed within 180 days/6 months after new tower is fully operational with all carriers –this will allow time for AT&T to install prior to T-Mobile cutover then Verizon.

12. The Council shall be notified in writing within 45 days of when the existing wood laminate tower is removed and the new steel monopole tower is operational unless a written request for an extension is submitted to the Council within that timeframe;

Comment: Acknowledged

13. The facility owner/operator shall remit timely payments associated with annual assessments and invoices submitted by the Council for expenses attributable to the facility under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50v;

Comment: Acknowledged

14. If the facility ceases to be used for signal transmission or reception in the electromagnetic spectrum pursuant to a Federal Communications Commission license for a period of one year, the facility owner/operator shall dismantle the tower and remove all associated equipment or reapply for any continued or new use to the Council within 90 days from the one year period of cessation of signal transmission or reception. The facility owner/operator may submit a written request to the Council for an extension of the 90 day period not later than 60 days prior to the expiration of the 90 day period; and

Comment: Acknowledged

15. This Declaratory Ruling may be transferred or partially transferred, provided both the facility owner/operator/transferor and the transferee are current with payments to the Council for their respective annual assessments and invoices under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50v. The Council shall be notified of such sale and/or transfer and of any change in contact information for the individual or representative responsible for management and operations of the facility within 30 days of the sale and/or transfer. Both the facility owner/operator/transferor and the transferee shall provide the Council with a written agreement as to the entity responsible for any quarterly assessment charges under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50v(b)(2) that may be associated with this facility, including contact information for the individual acting on behalf of the transferee.

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

At a public meeting held on April 13, 2023, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) considered and ruled that the above-referenced proposal would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need with the following conditions:

1. Approval of any project changes be delegated to Council staff;
2. Radio frequency access restriction and caution signage shall be installed at the site in compliance with FCC guidance;
3. Deployment of any 5G services must comply with FCC and FAA guidance relative to air navigation, as applicable;
4. Submission of the final construction drawings stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer duly licensed in the State of Connecticut prior to commencement of construction;
5. Submission of a structural analysis for the replacement tower/antenna mounts and foundation stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer duly licensed in the State of Connecticut prior to commencement of construction;
6. The final structural design shall include a yield point to ensure that the tower setback radius remains within the boundaries of the host property;
7. Submission of a landscaping plan for the tower compound prior to commencement of construction;
8. The Council shall be notified in writing at least two weeks prior to the commencement of site construction activities;
9. 14. If the facility ceases to be used for signal transmission or reception in the electromagnetic spectrum pursuant to a Federal Communications Commission license for a period of one year, the facility owner/operator shall dismantle the tower and remove all associated equipment or reapply for any continued or new use to the Council within 90 days from the one year period of cessation of signal transmission or reception. This Declaratory Ruling may be transferred or partially transferred, provided both the facility owner/operator/transferor and the transferee are current with payments to the Council for their respective annual assessments and invoices under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50v. The Council shall be notified of such sale and/or transfer and of any change in contact information for the individual or representative responsible for management and operations of the facility within 30 days of the sale and/or transfer. Both the facility owner/operator/transferor and the transferee shall provide the Council with a written agreement as to the entity responsible for any quarterly assessment charges under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50v(b)(2) that may be associated with this facility, including contact information for the individual acting on behalf of the transferee.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council and is not applicable to any other modification or construction. All work is to be implemented as specified in the petition dated February 2, 2023, and additional information received on March 24, 2023.
