Re: PETITION NO. 1567 – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling for the 1637/1720 Lines Rebuild Project, in Norwalk, Wilton, and Weston, Connecticut – **Notice of Construction Completion**

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On September 15, 2023, Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received a ruling from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) stating that the proposed 1637/1720 Lines Rebuild Project (“Project”) would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect. Among other conditions of the ruling, the Council required that Eversource submit the following item pursuant to Condition No. 10:

- Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that the construction has been completed along with a representative photograph of the project.

Construction was completed on March 5, 2025. Additionally, a representative photograph of the completed Project, is included as *Attachment A*.

Eversource will also be providing a submittal in Q2 2025 for this Project, as required in Petition Condition No. 6 of the Project’s ruling for a post-restoration wetland and watercourses report where temporary matting was utilized.
