RE: TS-ATT-161-241011 – New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) request for an order to approve tower sharing at an existing telecommunications facility located at 144 Chestnut Hill Road, Wilton, Connecticut.

PETITION NO. 1567 – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the 1637/1720 Lines Rebuild Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along its existing 4.0 mile electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kilovolt (kV) Nos. 1637 and 1720 Lines between Grist Mill Road in Norwalk, Norwalk Junction in Wilton, and Weston Substation in Weston, Connecticut traversing the municipalities of Norwalk, Wilton, and Weston, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements.

Dear Executive Director Bachman:

On behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T), we provide the following response to the Connecticut Siting Council's December 23, 2025 request to explore the feasibility of adding cost-effective screening methods at ground level to the above captioned facility.

In accordance with the Council's request, AT&T has modified the light for the equipment compound, so that it will only be activated when a technician is onsite.

Further, it is our understanding that Eversource Energy is developing a Proposed Planting Plan to add shrubbery and additional plantings around the existing equipment compound. Those plantings will be in addition to the existing sound attenuation blankets on the equipment area fence, which already mitigate visibility of the equipment. While AT&T has not been provided with a copy of Eversource Energy's proposed Planting Plan, it is our understanding that the proposed vegetation will adequately screen views of the equipment compound from Chestnut Hill Road so that further fencing or screening of the equipment will not be necessary.
