RE: **PETITION NO. 1573** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the Brookfield Junction to Bates Rock Substation Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 6.7 miles of its existing electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kilovolt (kV) Nos. 1887, 1268, and 1485 Lines between Brookfield Junction in Brookfield and Shepaug Substation in Newtown, and along approximately 0.5 mile of its existing electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kV Nos. 1622 and 1485 Lines between Shepaug Substation and Bates Rock Substation in Southbury, Connecticut traversing the municipalities of Brookfield, Newtown and Southbury, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements. **Request for Project Change.** 

### Dear Deborah Denfeld:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated April 19, 2024 regarding a project change to the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling issued by the Council on August 4, 2023.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's August 4, 2023 Declaratory Ruling, the request to add a gravel access road from Hilltop Road East to Structure 10138 and replace some matting with gravel at Structure 10138 in Southbury is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the project change in the correspondence dated April 19, 2024.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

Proposed Project Modifications

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On August 4, 2023, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued a declaratory ruling on Petition No. 1573 as referenced above. In accordance with Condition No. 1 of the ruling, Eversource is seeking Council staff approval for the following project changes, as shown on Attachment A - Map Sheet 15:

- Adding a gravel access road from Hilltop Road East to the work pad for Structure 10138
- Replacing some of the matting at the work pad for Structure 10138 with gravel

Upon closer review when starting construction, it was determined that the previously proposed matted access road from Structure 5312 to Structure 10138 does not provide enough clearance from the existing distribution line that is running parallel to the access road for large equipment to pass through the ROW.

Gravel is proposed to replace a portion of the matted work pad at Structure 10138 to provide a more stable surface on the slope on this portion of the work pad.

These proposed modifications will not result in any additional environmental effects as presented in the Petition. Both the gravel access road and the work pad will be restored at the completion of construction.

We have notified the Town of Southbury of the proposed modifications.

Eversource requests approval for the requested modifications. An original and two copies of this request will be mailed to your office.
