RE: **PETITION NO. 1573** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the Brookfield Junction to Bates Rock Substation Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 6.7 miles of its existing electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kilovolt (kV) Nos. 1887, 1268, and 1485 Lines between Brookfield Junction in Brookfield and Shepaug Substation in Newtown, and along approximately 0.5 mile of its existing electric transmission line right-of-way shared by its existing 115-kV Nos. 1622 and 1485 Lines between Shepaug Substation and Bates Rock Substation in Southbury, Connecticut traversing the municipalities of Brookfield, Newtown and Southbury, and related electric transmission line and substation improvements. **Request for Project Changes.** 

### Dear Deborah Denfeld:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated November 17, 2023 regarding project changes for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling issued by the Council on August 4, 2023, as follows:

- a) Eliminate two bridges, one over Currituck Road and one over Georges Hill Road, and associated access roads extending from the bridges, as they were deemed unnecessary;
- b) Add two pull pads, located east and west of Structures 4637/4637A, that were inadvertently omitted from Project Map Sheet 5; and
- c) Modify access to Structures 4620 through 4624 by constructing a new access road west of Structure 4619 and crossing the Housatonic Railroad.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's August 4, 2023 Declaratory Ruling, the specified requests for project changes are hereby approved. This approval applies only to the project changes in the correspondence dated November 17, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

**Proposed Project Modifications** 

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On August 4, 2023, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued a declaratory ruling on Petition 1573 referenced above. In accordance with Condition No. 1 of the ruling, Eversource is seeking Council staff approval for the following project changes:

1) Withdrawal of two proposed bridges, one over Currituck Road and the other over Georges Hill Road and associated access roads:

Upon closer review when preparing for start of construction, it was determined that these bridges are not needed for the Project. Attachment A is the revised Map Sheet 7 with the proposed Currituck Road bridge removed from the map. Attachment B is the revised Map Sheet 8 with the Georges Hill Road proposed bridge and the off-ROW access roads going from Georges Hill Road to Structures 4624 and 4625 removed from the map.

## 2) Add two pull pads:

These two pull pads, one between Structures 4637/4637A and 4638, and one between Structures 4637/4637A and 4636, were inadvertently omitted from the original Petition maps. Attachment C is the revised Map Sheet 5 showing the addition of these two pull pads.

3) Add an extension of the existing gravel off-ROW access road and a matted crossing of the Housatonic Railroad tracks:

Access to Structures 4620 through 4624 is proposed to be modified as coming from an easterly direction off of Hanover Road, instead of westerly from Currituck Road via the Georges Hill previously proposed bridge. It is proposed to construct an approximate 25 foot long off-ROW access from the Guard Truck Pull Pad with a matted crossing of the Housatonic railroad tracks, leading to the proposed extension of the existing gravel off-ROW access road. Attachment D is the revised Map Sheet 9 which shows the addition of the extended off-ROW access road, as well as the matted crossing of the railroad tracks. Housatonic Railroad representatives have been contacted about this proposed modification and approved the access and placement of temporary matting over the tracks.

These proposed modifications will not result in any additional environmental effects as presented in the Petition.

Eversource representatives will brief the officials in the Town of Newtown concerning the proposed project modifications

Eversource requests approval for the requested modifications. An original and two copies of this request will be mailed to your office.
