Dear Attorney Bachman:

In accordance with Condition No. 1 of the Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council's") September 1, 2023, Declaratory Ruling issued for the above-referenced facility, Eversource Energy ("Eversource") requests Council staff approval for work at Salisbury Substation on Sunday, March 17, 2024.

Work is required to complete structural fabrication and related bus work which has been delayed due to structural steel and fabrication issues. The proposed Sunday work, which would be from 8 AM to 7 PM and would be within the substation yard, and within an outage that will end on March 18.

Eversource has informed the Town of Salisbury about the proposed Sunday work and to date has received no objections from the town. Eversource also is informing the substation abutters about the proposed Sunday work.
