This approval applies only to the project change in the correspondence dated November 15, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

Re: **PETITION NO. 1575** – Salisbury Substation Transformer Replacement Project, located at 316 Indian Mountain Road, Salisbury, Connecticut. Project Change to Reduce the Proposed Fence Expansion.

Dear Attorney Bachman:

In accordance with Condition No. 1 of the Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council's") September 1, 2023, Declaratory Ruling issued for the above-referenced facility, Eversource Energy ("Eversource") provides the Council with the attached Site Plan revision¹, which illustrates a minor reduction in the planned Salisbury Substation ("Substation") fence expansion, as described below.

As discussed in the Petition, Eversource proposed the relocation of the northern substation fence by a uniform 15 feet to the north. This proposed fence relocation would have expanded the Substation by 0.07 acre (3,000 square feet).

However, upon the completion of initial civil work, Eversource determined that the expansion of the northwestern portion of the fence is not required. This expanded area was proposed for construction and maintenance vehicle parking and construction material storage, if necessary. However, Eversource has concluded that both parking and material storage can be accommodated at other locations on the Substation property.

Accordingly, Eversource plans to reduce the proposed fence expansion area by 0.023 acre (988 square feet). With this proposed project change, the total Substation yard expansion area is now 0.046 acre (2,012 square feet).

Specifically, approximately 55 feet of the existing fence (from the northwest fence corner to the east) will remain as is. The remaining portion of the fence will be expanded by 15 feet to the north, as previously proposed.

Specifically, approximately 55 feet of the existing fence (from the northwest fence corner to the east) will remain as is. The remaining portion of the fence will be expanded by 15 feet to the north, as previously proposed.

The table below updates the information that was provided in a similar tabular format as part of the response to the Council's Interrogatory 4.
