
This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated April 3, 2024.


Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Re: Petition No. 1582 – Pootatuck to West Devon Junction Rebuild Project - Request for Sunday Work Hours

Dear Attorney Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Connecticut Siting Council staff review and approval of Sunday work hours on April 7, 2024 from 7AM-4PM to support a ground crew that is prepping cellular facilities at the existing cellular shelter at Structure 19520 off of Chapel Street in Stratford on Eversource property. No noise impacts are anticipated. This request is required due to loss of production this week for planned work with weather delays and storm response needs. This work has a short window of completion in between the transmission line major construction in order to support the overall project and outage schedule.

There are no direct abutting residential property owners. We have notified the Town of Stratford of the proposed work schedule change and they have not expressed any concerns.
