**Re: Petition No. 1586 - Dominion Energy Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. Petition for a Declaratory Ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, that neither a new Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) nor a modification to its existing Certificate is required to revise the boundaries of the Millstone Power Station electric generating facility site located off Rope Ferry Road, Waterford, Connecticut.**

**Requests for Public Hearing**

Dear Attorney Bachman:

This letter is in response to two recent requests that the Siting Council (“Council”) received from Maureen Robertson and Joan Donovan for public hearing on the above-referenced Petition for Declaratory Ruling (“Petition”).

The Petitioner, Dominion Energy Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (“DENC”) appreciates the comments and interest in the Council Petition process, but it is clear from these requests that Ms. Robertson’s and Ms. Donovan’s concerns relate specifically to the development and operation of the NE Edge data center facility itself. As discussed in the Petition, and in the DENC recent responses to Council interrogatories, the data center use will be subject to local review and approval by the Waterford Conservation Commission (acting as its Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Authority) and Town’s Planning and Zoning Commission. Each of these processes will involve the submission of detailed application materials, a review by Town staff and public hearings before the local land use bodies. Ms. Robertson, Ms. Donovan and all other Waterford residents who have expressed concerns about the development of a data center at

Millstone Power Station (“MPS”) will have ample opportunity to present their concerns to the Town of Waterford, who ultimately has jurisdiction over the data center use.

The Petition seeks Siting Council approval for a limited purpose; to revise the identified “Site” boundary for the MPS, nothing more. The proposed data center use is not related to or associated with existing power generating operations at MPS and is not subject to the Council’s jurisdiction. We therefore respectfully request that the Council deny the requests for public hearing.
