RE:	<b>PETITION NO. 1589</b> – USS Somers Solar, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 3.0-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 360 Somers Road, Ellington Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection. <b>Completeness Review.</b>

## I. Introduction

The petition is from USS Somers Solar, LLC for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 3.0-megawatt alternating current solar photovoltaic electric generating facility in the Town of Ellington, Connecticut.

### II. Technical

The petition conforms to the Council's guide for *Petition for a Declaratory Ruling for a Renewable Energy Facility*, includes relevant maps, descriptions of the proposed project, costs, and the environmental effects of the proposed construction. The petition meets statutory and regulatory technical requirements for processing the petition. This project would not require an outside consultant.

#### III. Administrative Review

All service and filing requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-39 have been fulfilled.

## IV. Procedural

Pursuant to CGS § 4-176(e), within 60 days after receipt of a petition for a declaratory ruling, an agency in writing **shall**: (1) issue a declaratory ruling; (2) hold a public hearing on the matter; (3) decide to issue a declaratory ruling by a specified date; (4) decide to initiate regulation making proceedings; **or** (5) decide not to issue a declaratory ruling.

In response to requests for a public hearing on this petition, the Council voted to hold a public hearing during the Council meeting held on October 12, 2023. Staff recommends holding a public hearing via Zoom remote conferencing on December 5, 2023 and depositing the transcript in the Ellington Town Hall.
