The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated May 7, 2024 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on January 5, 2024.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM on Sunday, May 19, 2024 to support wire pull efforts on the 1090 line within a scheduled outage is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated May 7, 2024.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Re: Petition No. 1593 – Montville Substation to North of Kitemaug Road Rebuild Project - Request for Sunday Work Hours

Dear Attorney Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval of Sunday work hours on May 19, 2024 from 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM to support wire (conductor/OPGW) pull efforts from Structure 7602-1 into Montville Substation on the 1090 Line. This project work is limited to two days in May due to outage constraints relating to the summer moratorium for outages to also include the Saturday prior to the requested Sunday date.

Municipal officials were briefed about the proposed schedule change. The Town of Montville has a parade scheduled on May 19, but the project work will not impact the parade, and crews are aware of the road closures during the event. Municipal officials recommended a start time of 7:00 AM to accommodate parade logistics. Abutting property owners will also be notified of the proposed Sunday work hours.

We will continue to work with the Town of Montville and nearby abutters to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
