RE: **PETITION NO. 1594** - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed installation of a small wireless telecommunications facility on the roof of the Greenwich Country Club clubhouse and associated equipment at ground level located at 19 Doubling Road, Greenwich, Connecticut. **Tolling of Federal Communications Commission deadline.**

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received the petition for the above-referenced facility on October 6, 2023. During a regular meeting held on November 9, 2023, the Council voted to set the date by which to render a decision on the petition as no later than January 4, 2024 in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes §4-176(e) and Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50v-3: "The Council shall refrain from considering any pending and future matters filed by any person who fails to pay invoice and assessment amounts that are past due to the Council by 30 days or more under §16-50v of the Connecticut General Statutes."

On November 30, 2023, the Council provided notice to Verizon that it has 14 invoices that are more than 30 days past due and, pursuant to RCSA §16-50v-3, the Council will not process any pending Verizon filings until payment is received. Therefore, the Council will not further process the above-referenced petition until payment of the 14 outstanding invoices is received.

This notice shall have the effect of tolling the FCC 90-day deadline for a decision for a proposed small wireless facility on a new structure in accordance with FCC regulations.
