Re: PETITION NO. 1598 – Windsor Solar One, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 3.0-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 445 River Street, Windsor, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Windsor Solar One, LLC, in connection with the above-referenced Petition. In accordance with the Council's Decision and Order dated May 9, 2024, Condition No. 4. and the Council's Decision regarding the Development and Management Plan dated March 6, 2025 (the "Decisions"), this letter shall serve as notice to the Council that Windsor Solar One intends to commence within two weeks.

Also enclosed with this letter is the final structural design drawing for the racking system and updated site plans that reflect the addition of a second pole by Eversource at the location where the service enters the property. This change was dictated by Eversource Field Engineering at a recent on-site meeting. An original and fifteen hard copies of these materials shall be delivered to the Council.

In accordance with the Decisions, abutting property owners will be notified of commencement of construction and the types of construction activities. A copy of that letter will be provided under separate cover, along with the fully executed and signed Hold Harmless Agreement.
