Endurant Energy is undertaking a project that involves the installation of a 4.9-megawatt Battery Energy Storage System, electrical interconnection and associated equipment (collectively, the "Project") to be located at 65 Vine Street in Middletown, Connecticut.

This letter is to provide you notice that on or about January 3, 2024, Endurant Energy intends to submit to the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") a petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Sections 4-176 and 16-50k, that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is necessary, for the proposed construction, maintenance, and operation of the Project. Pursuant to Section 16-50j-40 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Endurant Energy is notifying you of its intent to submit the petition.

The Council will undertake a thorough review of the proposed Project and consider input from interested stakeholders. If the Project is approved by the Council, Endurant Energy anticipates starting construction during the first quarter of 2025, and commercial operation of the facility will be expected to commence no later than June 1, 2025. 

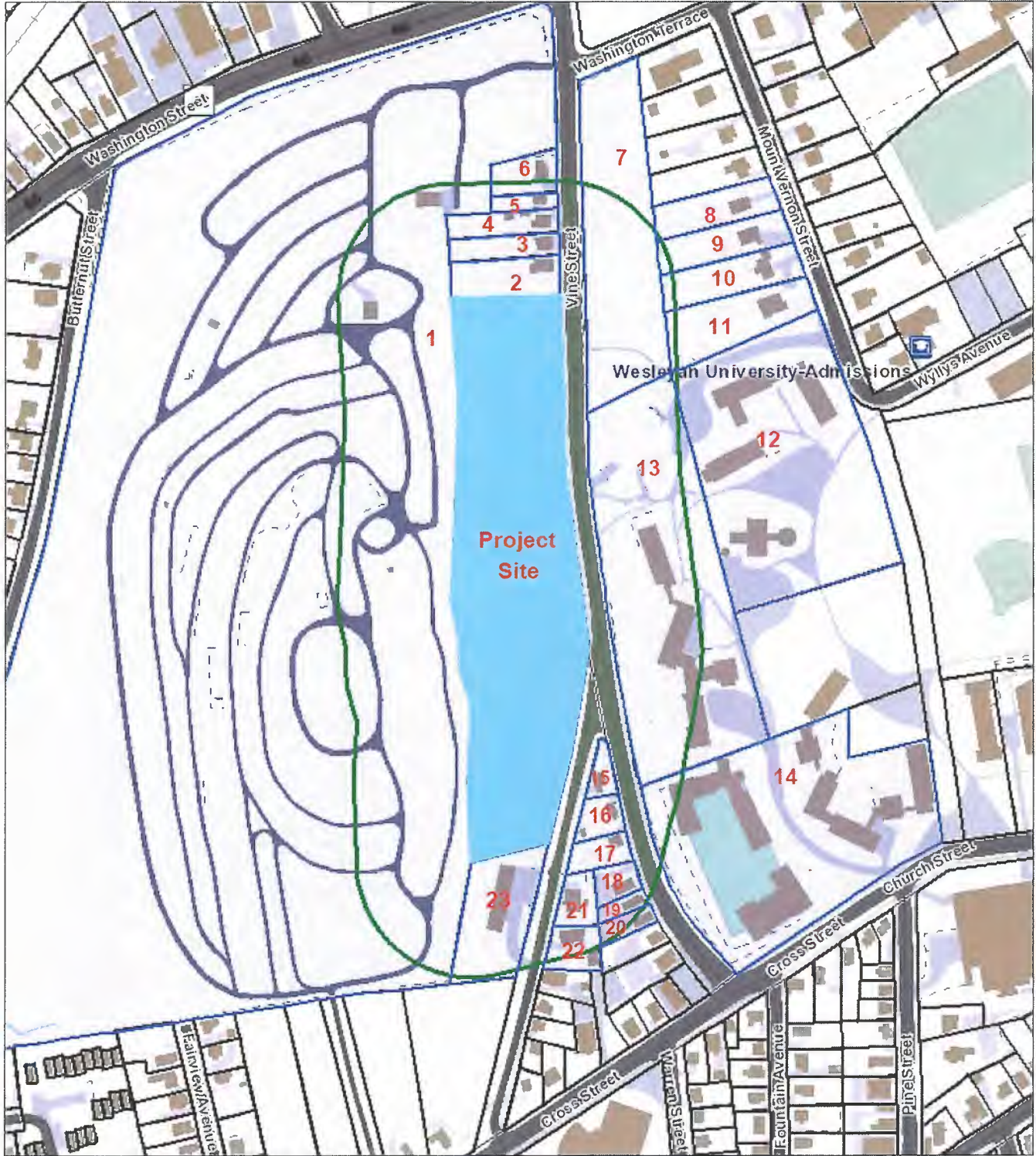
