I am writing on behalf of my client Hanwha Q Cells America Inc. (“Petitioner”) in connection with the above-captioned Petition.

The Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) granted Petitioner’s Motion for Extension of Time to provide responses to the Council’s Interrogatories to Petitioner - Set 2 on April 12, 2024, establishing a May 14, 2024 timeline for response.

Pursuant to § 16-50j-22a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, the Petitioner respectfully moves for a second extension of time in which to provide responses to the questions contained in Council Interrogatories to Petitioner - Set 2 to May 28, 2024.
