HOCA is currently working on updating the Petition No. 1607A Exhibit B – Revised Site Plans to reflect the changes to the point of interconnection and the proposed path of interconnection discussed in Petitioner's September 23, 2025 responses to Council Interrogatory Nos. 9.b-14. Petitioner will submit such updated site plans to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for its review as soon as they are finalized.

Petitioner also continues to work with its fire response organization partner, Fire & Risk Alliance, on an updated emergency response plan ("ERP") and will similarly submit a working draft of such ERP to the Council for its review as soon as the working draft is completed.
