RE: **PETITION NO. 1611** – LSE Scutum LLC and LSE Bootes LLC (Lodestar Energy) petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 1.93-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 141 Town Farm Road, and Parcel Nos. 86-326 and 86-164, Abbe Road, Enfield, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection.

Continuation of Evidentiary Hearing

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) shall continue the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced proceeding on **Tuesday**, **June 4**, **2024**, via Zoom remote conferencing, beginning at **2:00 p.m.** A copy of the Instructions for Public Access to the Continued Evidentiary Hearing is attached.

The hearing shall commence with the continued appearance of the Petitioner, LSE Scutum LLC and LSE Bootes LLC (Lodestar Energy) for cross examination by the parties and intervenors in the order by which requests were granted by the Council, beginning with the Town of Enfield (Town) and continuing with the Grouped Resident Intervenors, to be followed by cross examination of the Petitioner by the Council on the new exhibits.

The hearing shall proceed with the appearances of the parties and intervenors in the order by which the requests were granted by the Council, commencing with the appearance of the Town followed by the appearance of the Grouped Resident Intervenors for cross examination by all parties and intervenors and the Council.

Petitioner Late-Filed Exhibits

During the May 16, 2024 evidentiary hearing session, the Council requested Lodestar Energy submit the following information as late-filed exhibits:

- 1. Spill Incident Report Sheet;
- 2. Revised Northern Array fence line to remove open space from the array;
- 3. Alternate Site Plan to include electrical pads and inverter racking in a centralized location; and
- 4. List of alternate sites considered for solar development.

During the May 16, 2024 evidentiary hearing session, the Council requested the Town submit the following information as a late-filed exhibit:

1. Bike Path Plan
