# Petition No. 1611 LSE Scutum LLC and LSE Bootes LLC (Lodestar) 141 Town Farm Road, and Parcel Nos. 86-326 and 86-164, Abbe Road, Enfield

### Development & Management (D&M) Plan Interrogatories

- 1. Referencing Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling and D&M Plan p. 1, what is the status of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) Stormwater Permit?
- 2. Has Lodestar consulted with the Town regarding the coordination of facility construction activities to minimize disruption to the development of the multi-use trail, as recommended in the Council's Declaratory Ruling decision letter dated October 25, 2024? If yes, summarize the consultation. If not, when will the consultation occur?
- 3. Referencing Site Plan Sheet 4, the site layout is different than what the Council approved in its October 25, 2024 Declaratory Ruling. What is the reason for the changes in panel row width (horizontal projection), number of rows and width of the vegetated aisles between panel rows?
- 4. Can the vegetated aisles between the panel rows in the southern array be decreased from 21 feet to 14 feet, as initially proposed, to allow for a larger buffer to the multi-use trail and residential areas to the south? Explain.
- 5. How many inverters are proposed for the northern and southern arrays?
- 6. Site Plan Sheet 5 states construction is anticipated to begin in Fall 2024 with completion by Summer 2025. Provide a revised construction schedule.
- 7. Referencing the Spill Prevention Control Plan, it states "Refueling of vehicles or machinery shall occur within the Construction Laydown Area...a minimum of 100 feet from wetlands or watercourses and the aquifer protection area on the Site." Identify the limits of the aquifer protection area. Identify the location of the laydown area.
- 8. Revise the Spill Prevention Control Plan to include the contact information of the construction contractor and *appropriate local, state and/or federal agencies*, as referenced in the plan.
