Re: **Petition No. 1624** – Sandy Hook Substation Fence Expansion and Planting Project, Newtown

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On June 6, 2024, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) issued a ruling that Eversource Energy’s (“Eversource”) above-referenced Project would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with conditions. Among other conditions of the ruling, the Council required in Condition 6 that Eversource submit the following item:

- Within 45 days after completion, the Council shall be notified in writing that the construction has been completed, along with a representative photograph of the facility modification.

Construction was completed on September 13, 2024.

A representative photograph of the completed project is included as *Attachment A*.

Eversource will be providing one original and two hard copies of this notice in the mail for the Council’s records.
